MINISTRY SCHEDULE

From September to approximately June, the Family Choir sings about twice a month at one of the three weekend masses.

In addition, the choir sings for special liturgies at Christmas and Easter and for Confirmation.

Dates and times are posted at the beginning of each semester.

SPECIAL ROLES

Choristers are asked to volunteer for special roles, such as Choir Librarian, Sunshine Fund Coordinator, Cantors at liturgy, etc.

ABOUT FAMILY CHOIR

THE REHEARSAL SCHEDULE
